




2. Slide Wheels(Part 5) onto the extended threaded ends of the Rear Axle Support(Part 6).








1. Attach the Steering Link
Connector(Part 12) to the
Front Axle Support(Part 9) by
threading two M8 x 15 Bolts
(Part 23) through the top of the
Link connector (Part 12) and
into the Axle Support(Part 9).
Secure at the bottom with
Washer(Part 19) and then
Lock Nut(Part 20). Tighten
clockwise until secure.


2. Join the Yoke(Part 11) and the Center Front Axle Brace(Part 10) to the Front Axle Support(Part 9) by first threading one M8 x 25 Bolt(Part 24) through the hole in the Center Front Axle Brace(Part 10), then into the second hole



in the Yoke(Part 11) and through the hole in the bottom of the Front Axle Support(Part 9). From the bottom, insert Washer(Part 19) and secure with Lock Nut(Part 20). Tighten clockwise until secure.

- 3. Secure the Yoke (Part 11) to the Steering Link Connector(Part 12) by threading one M8 x 15 Bolt(Part 23) through the first hole in the Yoke(Part 11) then into the Link Connector(Part 12). Secure With Washer(Part 19) and Lock Nut(Part 20). Tighten clockwise until secure.
- 4. Attach the top of the Yoke(Part 11) to the appendage located on the under side(top) of the Front Axle Support(Part 9) by first inserting Large Yoke Washer(Part 26) and then inserting Cotter Pin(Part 17) into the hole in the middle of the appendage. NOTE: Use a flat Head Screwdriver to separate

4.CONTINUED..and bend the end of the Cotter Pin outwards to lock it into place.




 Secure Wheels first with Washer(Part 25), and large lock Nut (Part 21). Tighten Large Lock Nut clockwise until wheels are secure.









1. With the Bed(Part 1) turned upside down, attach the Back wheel assembly to the Bed by inserting six M8 x 15 Steering Bolts(Part 23) from under the bar first through the holes located on the metal support bars on the under side of the Bed then into the holes located on both the Left and Right Rear Axle Brace(Parts 7 and 8) and also the Rear Axle Support (Part 6). Next insert Washers (Parts 19) onto the Bolts then secure with Lock Nuts (Parts 20). Tighten Lock Nuts clockwise until secure.



- 2. Join the Front Wheel Assembly to the Bed(Part 1) by inserting four more M8 x 15 Steering Bolts(Parts 23) first from under the bar through the holes in the metal support bars then into the holes in both the Front Axle Support(Part 9) and the Center Front Axle Brace(Part 10). Insert Washers(Part 19) onto the Bolts then secure with Lock Nuts(Part 20).
- 3. Attach either the Pull Handle(Part 14) or the Tractor Pull Adapter(Part 15) to the Yoke(Part 11) depending on which you would prefer to use.



- A. CONTINUED...Connect to the end of your Tractor using Tractor Pull Bolt(Part 27), Secure on the other side with Small Quick Release Pin(Part 28).
- B. Pull Handle Attach the Tractor Pull in the same manner as Step A. Instead of attaching to Tractor, use Tractor Pull Bolt(Part 27) and Small Quick Release Pin(Part 28) to attach Pull Handle. Insert The "U" shaped end of the Tractor Pull Adapter into the end of the Pull Handle. Align holes







- 1. Join the Back Panel (Part 4) to the Bed (Part 1) by inserting two Quick Release Pins (Part 16) through the side loop located at the bottom of the Back Panel and the lop edge of the Bed.
- 2. Join the side Panels(Part 2) to the Bed (Part 1) by inserting four more Quick Release Pins(Part 16)

two per Side Panel-into the loops at the bottom of the Side Panels and the top edge of the Bed.

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
